

Junk in Your Trunk seller guidelines

Thank you for your interest in being a seller at our second Junk in Your Trunk Community Garage Sale at the Fruitland Grange! We are excited to offer this event and expect a great turnout of sellers and buyers!

GENERAL:

- The sale will be open for customers from 9am 3pm on Saturday, August 17, 2024 at the Fruitland Grange: 11102 86th Ave E, Puyallup, WA 98373
- Seller fee is \$20/space if paid by check or \$21.23 if paid by PayPal/debit/credit
- Sellers will get a spot in our gravel/grass parking lot; **approximately** 18' x 18' in which to set up the items they are selling. Their vehicle must also fit in their 18' x 18' space.
- Customers will park outside of the sale area and walk around through the seller area. (See map below)

SET-UP:

- 7:00 am 8:30 am. All vehicles must be checked in and parked by 8:30am no exceptions.
- The sale begins at 9:00am and ends at 3:00pm.
- If you have someone you want to set up next to, please arrive at the same time so we can park you next to each other. We will not be able to hold spaces.
- Vehicles will be parked tightly in the area, and there will most likely not be room for more than one car per spot. If a seller must bring two vehicles to transport their items, the second vehicle may need to park outside the seller area and items may need to be carried in to their assigned spot.
- Vehicles parked in the sale area must remain until the end of the event. No vehicles will be allowed to drive into or out of the sale area after 8:30am or before 3:00pm
- Seller vehicles must be in their assigned area, not in the customer parking area.
- This event will run rain or shine. There will be no refunds issued for no shows.

SELLERS RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Sellers are responsible for bringing items to sell that match a "Junk in Your Trunk" sale. Garage sale type items, not homemade crafts or new re-sale items, etc. The one exception is a food truck.
- Sellers are responsible for loading, unloading, and setting up their space. We do not provide tables, chairs, or tents for this event.
- Sellers are responsible for providing their own change, for pricing items, and for collection of payment.
- Any unsold items must be loaded back up and removed from the area by 4:00 pm.
- Sellers must take their big garbage with them (boxes, packing materials, unsold items, etc) The dumpster is NOT for sellers.
- Items for sale must be appropriate as this is a family event. We retain the right to ask sellers to remove items deemed inappropriate or offensive to the public. This includes weapons of any type.
- All items for sale and sellers vehicle must fit in the allotted parking space(s) provided, which will be **approximately** equivalent to 2 parking stalls (18' x 18')
- Sellers space/vehicle must be supervised at all times. Fruitland Grange is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged items/vehicles; nor any injuries sustained during the set-up, sale time, or tear-down.
- The restrooms and the refrigerator in the Grange building will be available for sellers to use.
- We hope to find a food truck to set up during the event, but please bring your own food in case we don't.
